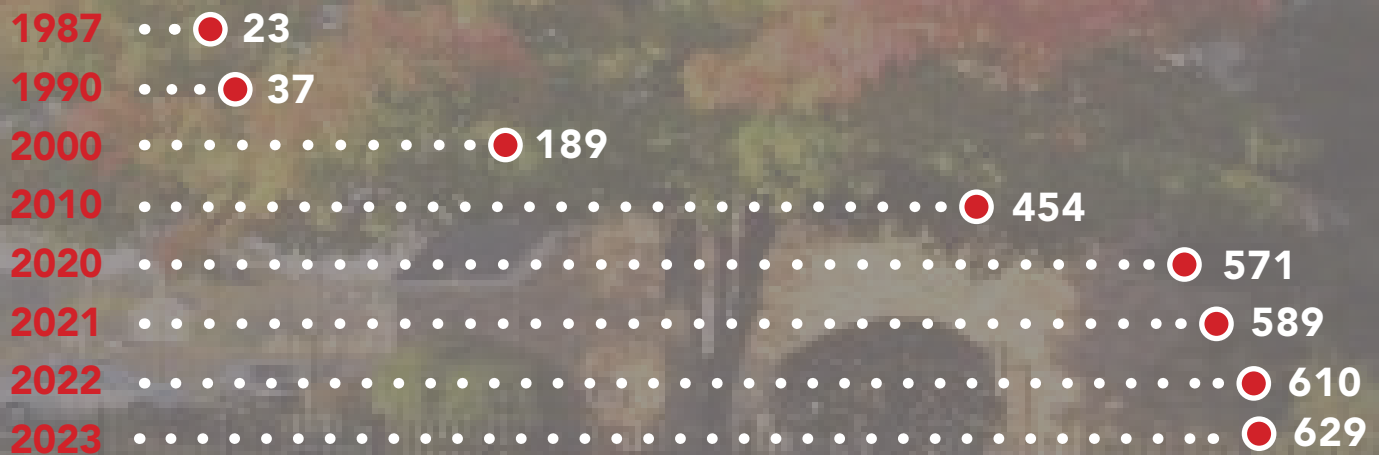

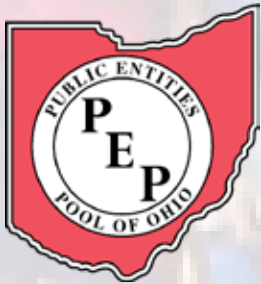

WHAT IF IT HAPPENED HERE? EMERGENCY RESPONSE TRAINING

The PEP Regional Training Best Practices Before the Emergency, hosted in September of 2023, provided an understanding of critical incident management roles and best practices for public administration officials. The training involved an introduction of the Incident Response System, associated problems, and a detailed presentation of the resources available to public entities beyond the immediate response phase. The training included information and resources to help prepare public entity administrations before, during, and after an incident occurs. Public entities were provided the tools to self-evaluate their ability to respond and recover from unexpected incidents in order to better serve their communities. The presentation was based on an actual case study: PEP Risk Services assistance provided to the Village of East Palestine following the train derailment in 2023.

- Escalation of a large-scale incident and available resources
- Public Information Best Practices
- Role expectations for the Mayor, Administrator, Fiscal Personnel, Public Services and other public entity positions
- Fiscal administration and recouping costs for large-scale incidents
- Preparedness: Best practices and training resources

UNDERSTANDING EVERY PIECE. AUTISM RESPONSE FOR FIRST RESPONDERS

The PEP Regional Training Autism Response for First Responders, hosted in May of 2023, featured guest speaker Bart Barta of Autism Safety 101. This Regional Training focused on helping first responders learn best practices, communication tactics, and other strategies for interacting inclusively and empathetically with members of the community. This regional training provided an understanding of autism and how individuals with autism behave, communicate, and react in various situations. Attendees of this training received useful skills in handling high risk, crisis incidents involving individuals with autism.

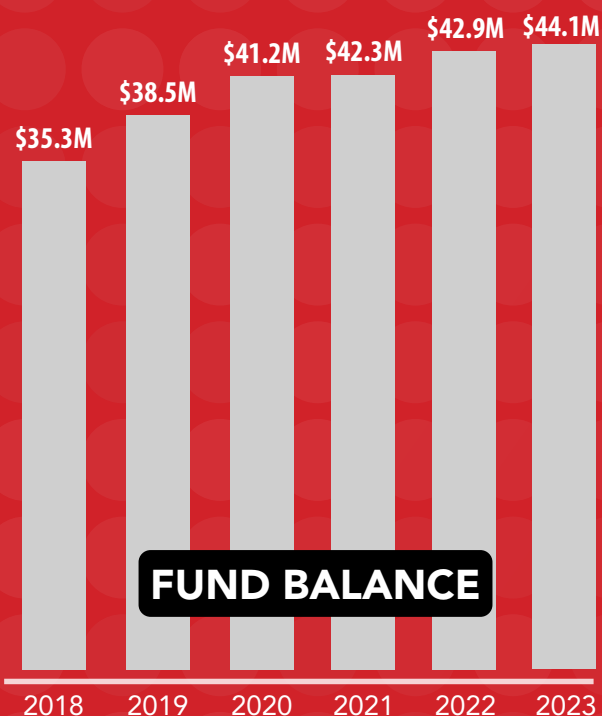
