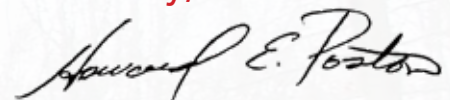
Your PEP Board of Directors is committed to the long-term success of our members.

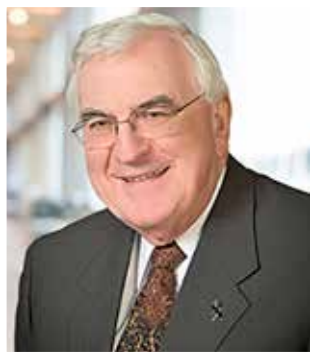

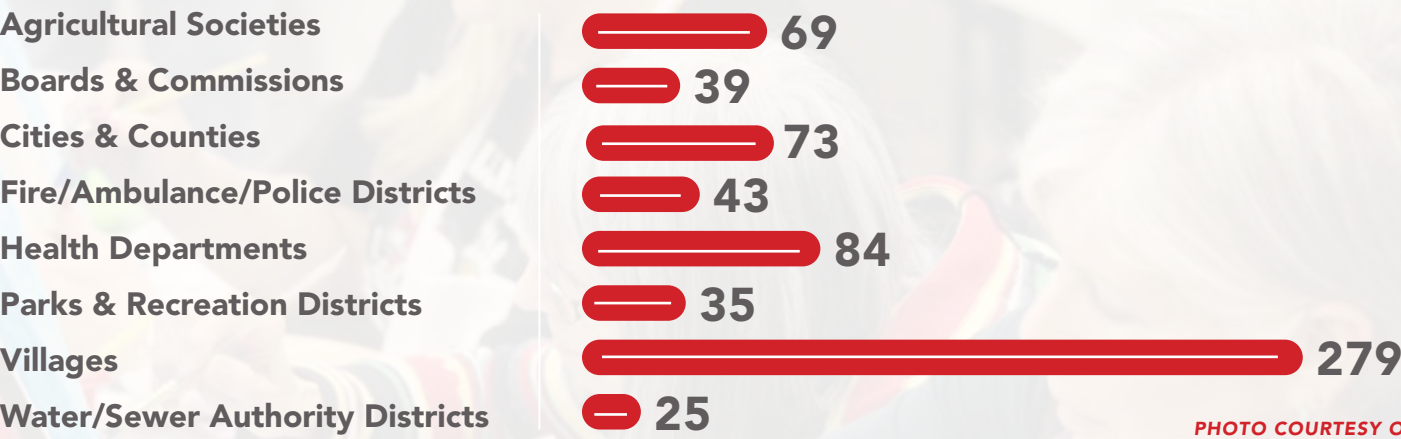

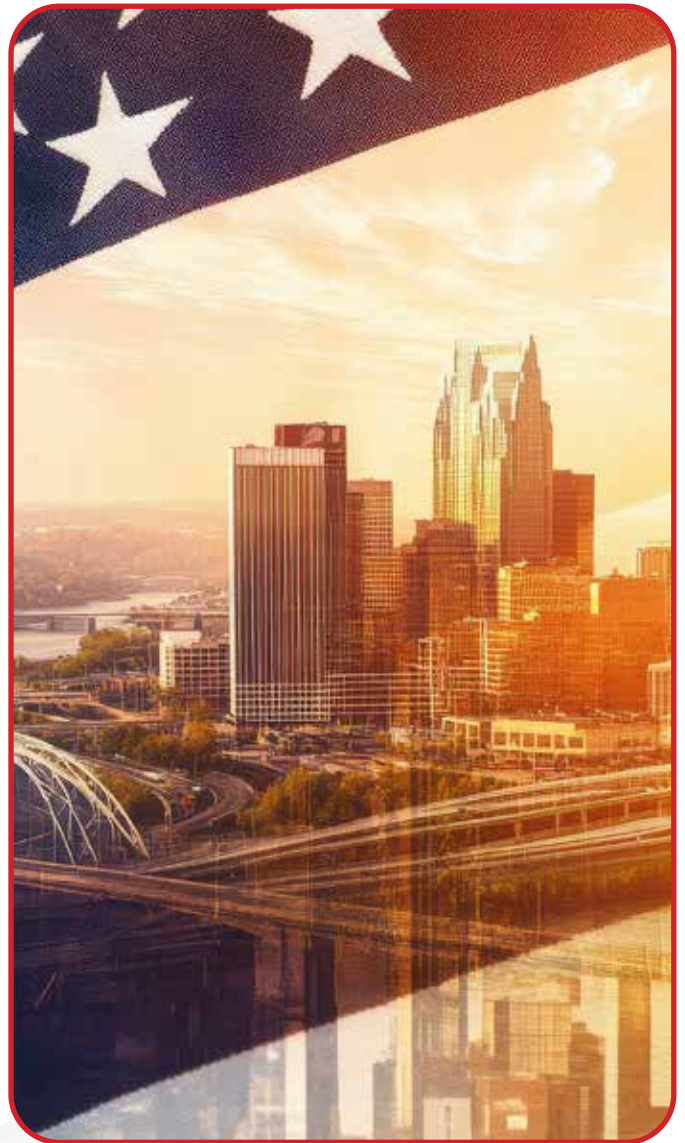
RISK SERVICES SUPPORT FOR MEMBERS

The Risk Services team plays a pivotal role in supporting PEP members by delivering strategic risk management solutions, enhancing operational resilience, and maximizing the value of pooling. This story outlines the key service areas that demonstrate the team's impact and alignment with the board's commitment to member success.

Risk Services supports members in modernizing their employee handbooks through the PEP handbook builder, a platform integrated with The Guide and Zywave. This tool enables members to consolidate outdated policies and adopt best practices. The team provides personalized onboarding, including virtual or in-person walkthroughs, and offers real-time assistance by monitoring draft handbooks. This proactive engagement ensures members are equipped with compliant and customized policies.

To help members secure external funding, Risk Services offers comprehensive grant assistance. This includes reviewing narratives, guiding members through federal systems like SAM.gov, and conducting targeted searches for grants aligned with member priorities such as public safety, infrastructure, and training. **The team also maintains a curated list of public entity grant opportunities, ensuring members have access to timely and relevant funding sources.**

Preparedness is a cornerstone of public service, and Risk Services reinforces this through regional and conference-based training on **Emergency Operations Plans (EOPs) and the Incident Command System (ICS)**. Members benefit from access to sample EOPs, Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), and Incident Action Planning templates, which strengthen their ability to respond effectively to emergencies.



When members launch new programs, Risk Services provides strategic risk evaluations to identify potential liabilities and recommend mitigation strategies. This consultative approach ensures that innovation is balanced with safety and compliance, supporting sustainable program implementation.

To reduce employment-related claims, **Risk Services delivers guidance on best practices in human resources.** Members receive training and templates for harassment prevention, hiring, evaluations, and disciplinary procedures. These resources promote consistency, fairness, and legal defensibility across member organizations.

Finally, Risk Services educates members on the strategic value of pooling. Through collaboration with marketing, claims, and underwriting teams, the team helps members understand their roles and responsibilities within the pool. This education fosters a culture of shared accountability and informed decision-making, reinforcing the long-term strength of the PEP model.

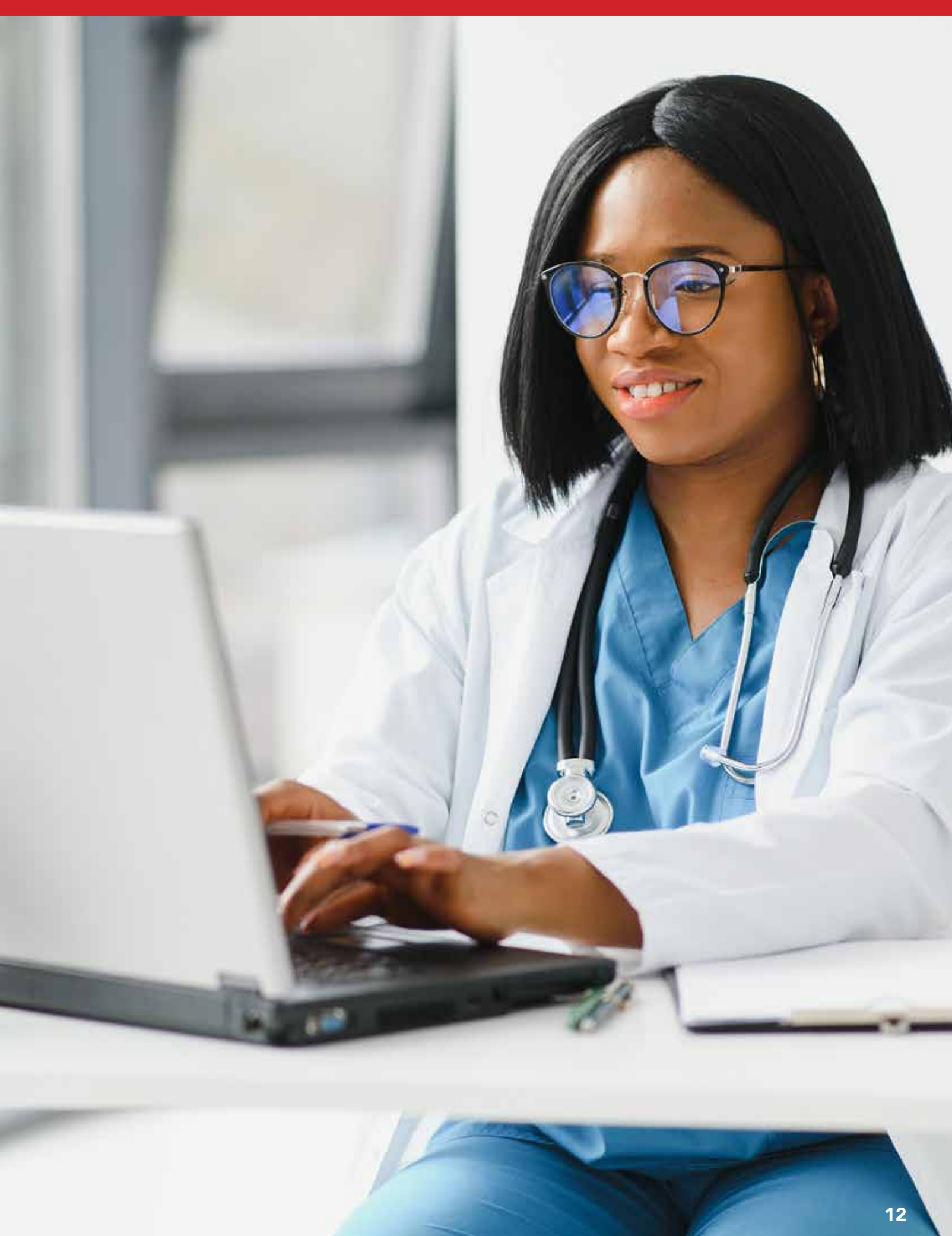

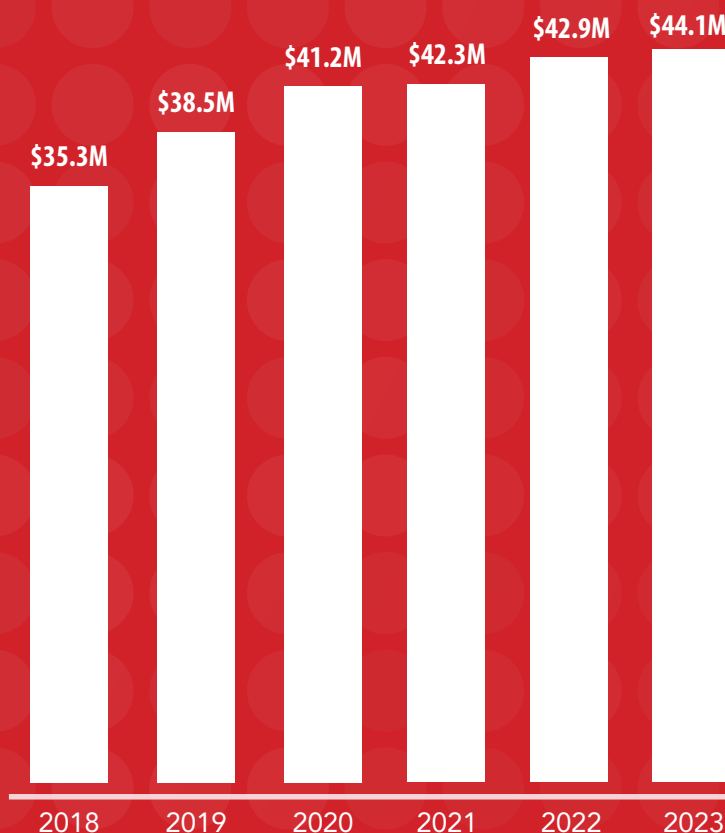

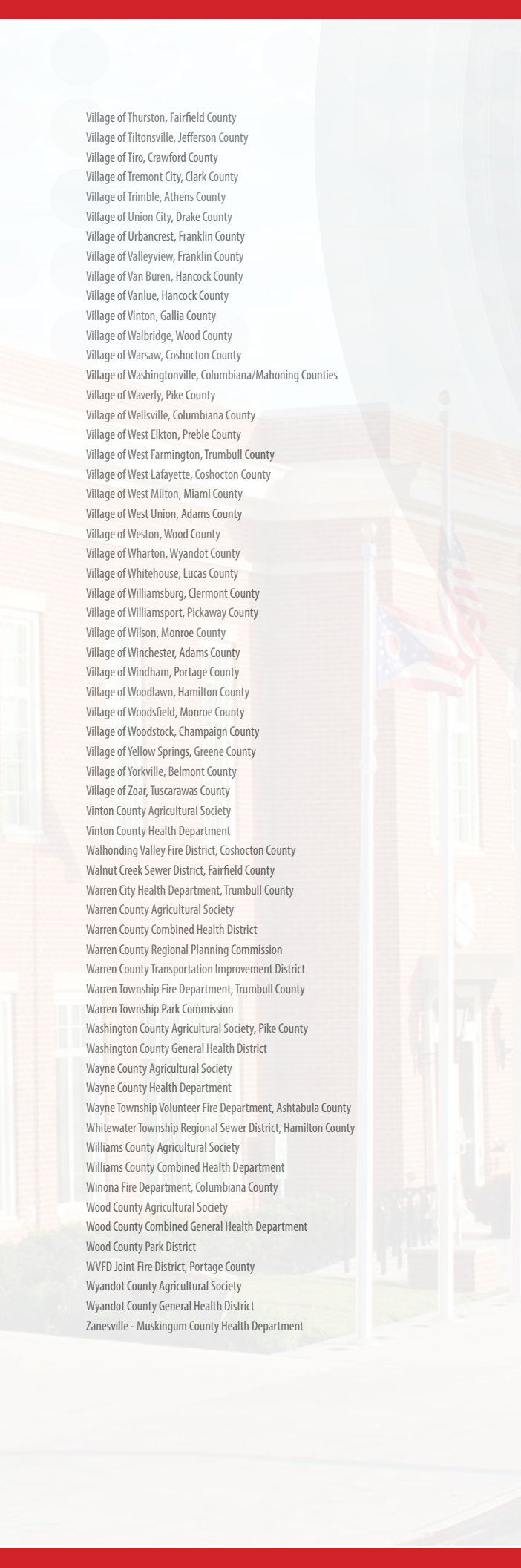
