### Clear Paths

Provide a sledding path that is free of objects that could be impacted, such as trees, rocks, cement barriers, etc.

### Run-Out Area

Establish a run-out area at the bottom of the hill that is a minimum of two times the height of the hill.

### Documented Inspections

Regularly inspect and maintain approved hills as needed, and document the inspections and maintenance.

### Welcome Spring!

The following three tips will help ensure visitors have safe access to enjoy the sights and sounds of your parks' scenic trails.

### Review Signage

Inspect signs for wear and stability. Replace signs if the wording is no longer visible.

### Inspect for Debris

Branches or trees may have fallen onto a trail and need to be removed. Leftover fall leaves or gravel may need to be swept or blown off the trail.

### Inspect for Drainage Issues

Inspect the trail for signs of drainage issues or the pooling of mud to ensure the issues are addressed before the trail is opened.

### Don't Forget!

Spring is a great time to submit your beautiful PEP member photos for the 2022 Calendar! And while you're out, here are three safety tips to follow.

#### Tree Trimming

Have damaged branches removed by a professional to prevent property damage or personal injury.

#### Test Smoke Alarms

Test your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors. Follow the manufacturer's instructions, and while you're up on the ladder, replace the batteries.

#### Ladder Safety

Make sure the ladder you use isn't too short. Place it on firm, level ground. Set ladders at a 75-degree angle and have another person secure the bottom.

### Signs and Symptoms of Heat Stroke

Higher temperatures and humidity increase your risk of heat stroke so its especially important this time of year to recognize the following symptoms.

#### High Body Temperature

A body temperature of 104 degrees (40 degrees C) or higher is the main sign of heat stroke.

#### Cessation of Sweating

This is often one of the first signs that body temperature is too high. With heat stroke brought on by hot weather, skin is hot and dry to the touch.

#### Hyperventilation

Breathing may become rapid and shallow, potentially leading to tingling sensations and feeling faint.

## Summer Safety Tips

Here are some ways you can avoid hazards associated with sunny, summer months and activities.

### The 20 Minute Rule

Drink water at least every 20 minutes. To prevent heat stress and heat stroke, adults and children should stay hydrated when outside on hot and humid days.

### Sunburn

Avoid sunburn by applying SPF 15 (or higher) sunscreen to exposed skin 30 minutes before exposure. For children under 6 months old, consult a physician before using any sunscreen.

### Professional Fireworks

The National Safety Council advises everyone enjoy fireworks at public displays conducted by professionals, and not to use them at home.

### Fall is a Great Time to Inspect Trees

Following some tree inspection guidelines will help uncover issues before they cause serious damage.

### Scheduled Inspections

Tree inspection should be part of regularly scheduled maintenance, especially in areas of pedestrian traffic.

### Pruning

Remove dead and broken branches to prevent a potential fall hazard.

### Rot and Decay

Inspect trees for structural problems such as rot, decay, multiple trunks, leaning, infestation or cracks.

### Haunted House Safety Tips

Haunted Houses can certainly be fun and scary, but they can also be dangerous if the right precautions aren't taken.

### Safe Location

Choose a safe location that includes parking lots with sufficient vehicle access and egress, functioning smoke detectors and certified sprinkler systems, and emergency back-up lighting.

### First Aid Kits

Place first-aid kits that include automatic external defibrillators (AEDs) in visible locations.

### Flame Resistant Materials

Highly flammable materials, such as cotton batting, straw, dried plant material and certain plastics, should not be used for decoration or construction. However, if used, they should be treated with an appropriate flame retardant.

Every PEP Member is eligible for up to 90 minutes of free legal consultation per year, covering issues associated with human resources, zoning, land use, open records/ open meetings, and more.
